Precious Little Linhardt Design Studio's Lisa Linhardt insists on using recycled and sustainable materials for her custom and ready-to-wear necklaces, bracelets, and earrings. For her New York store, repurposing was just as high a priority. The first-ever retail project by Wary Meyers Decorative Arts, the 190-square-foot space boasts flooring of fir, pine, and ash rescued from sites in Maine; display cases made of pine salvaged from barns; and pendant fixtures that are actually plaster planters bolted together. What's the door handle? A leg from a 1970's sofa.
